

Range Commands

“Range is Active”

- Red Flag is up
- You may cross the cease fire line and approach the firing line
- You may handle, pack, unpack your firearms at the firing line, set up rests, scopes, etc
- You may load detachable magazines but not insert them into the firearm
- **You may NOT load your firearms or chamber a round!**
- When the range is active nobody is allowed to cross the firing line

“Eye and Ear Protection On”

- Everybody in attendance must put on their eye and ear protection

“On Your Own Time, Downrange, Commence Fire”

- You may load your firearms and commence shooting downrange

“Cease Fire, Unload and Show Clear”

- **All firing must stop**
- Unload your firearm, remove detachable magazines, lock open the action
- PROVE your firearm
- Leave firearm on the table, action open and step behind ceasefire line
- RO will inspect all firearms to ensure they are unloaded and safe

“Range is Not Active, Check and Replace your Targets”

- All firearms are unloaded, magazines removed and actions locked open
- Open chambers are displayed per RO's (Range Officer) instruction
- Chamber flags are used in firearms which cannot be locked open
- Everybody in attendance is behind the ceasefire (red) line
- Firearms and ammunition on the firing line will NOT be handled at this time - **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- People are not permitted to cross over the cease fire (red) line at this time - **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Shooters may exit the sides of the structure and proceed down range to check/change targets
- When returning to the structure stay behind the cease fire (red) line until instructed by RO

“Has Everybody Returned From Downrange?”

- **ALL** personnel should visually check to make sure nobody is left downrange and everybody is behind the cease fire line

Remember: Any Member may call a cease fire at any time!
